Mass ABHA creation and ABDM awareness drive in higher educational institutions - regarding.

The Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) aims to develop the backbone necessary to support the integrated digital health infrastructure of the country. It will bridge the existing gap amongst different stakeholders of healthcare ecosystem frough digital highways, making healthcare available, accessible and affordable. As you may be aware, ABDM has successfully completed one year of nationwide implementation. During this phase, about 25 crore Ayushman Bharat Health Account (ABHA) have been created and more than 2 crore digital health records have been linked to citizens' ABHA.

e interoperable platform created through ABDM enables creation of tudinal electronic health records for every citizen. Through ABHA and ABDM enabled Personal Health Record (PHR) applications, citizens shall have the facility to which, securely store and access their medical records digitally. This gives citizens complete control over their health records and ability to choose what to share with their healthcare providers. The youth of our country are tech-savvy and wants everything at a click. ABDM would enable them to have ready access to their comprehensive health records and would assist them in seeking the best health care solution for themselves. Creating ABHA for them and making them aware of the ABDM ecosystem through their educational institution will help them in the development of their longitudinal health records.

There are a number of applications through which ABHA can be created. These include ABHA App, Aarogya Setu besides other applications developed by private players like Paytm, Driefcase and ekacare. The procedure for creation of ABHA is annexed herewith for your reference.
