State Government's policy for granting NOC/recommendation to NCTE for establishing new teacher education colleges/opening new programme*/increase in seats in the ongoing approved programmes for session 2021-22 shall be as under.

Note:

- a. NOC/Recommendation for increase of seats in any of existing programme/course/college of teacher education shall not be allowed in session 2021-22
- b. The State policy shall be applicable to private universities as well. The Private Universities, prior to submitting application to NCTE, as per Regulation point no 5(3), shall obtain NOC of the State government. NAAC accreditation is mandatory for those institutions which have completed 5 years since their inception. The aspirant private universities should get NOC from the State Government latest by 31st March, 2020.
- c. Shifting of campus for a teacher-education programme shall not be allowed to a tehsil which already had teacher-education programme/course/college, if NOC/recommendation of State Government was given for a tehsil without teacher education college i.e. shifting of open tehsil to 'banned tehsils' (which had a teacher-education college as per policy applicable for that particular session, will not be allowed).
- d. No Institution shall be allowed to partly admit students through State level coordinator and partly at its own level or entrance test conducted by their association.
- e. The restrictions shall not be applicable to Minority institutions established under Article 30 of the constitution.
- f. The restrictions regarding opening new teacher education programmes/courses or increase of seats shall not be applicable to those State-funded universities (including State funded Open University) which have been assigned jurisdiction to affiliate teacher-education courses. This will ensure that affiliating universities develop in-house strength for various academic and administrative tasks that an affiliating university is expected to perform.
- g. Only those colleges which are regularly running both faculties of Arts and Sciences will be eligible for conducting the ITEP program. The said applicant colleges will be eligible to apply to the NCTE, only after obtaining NOC from the affiliating university.
- h. Only those aspirants will be admitted to the courses mentioned in the above table from S.No. 7 to 11, who have stood in the merit and qualified the entrance test conducted by the State level coordinator..


