At present it has six Sub Divisions and six Tehsils, Dholpur, Bari, Baseri, Rajakhera, Saipau & Sarmathura and five Development Blocks namely Dholpur, Bari, Baseri, Rajakhera and Saipau.

It is bordered by Bharatpur district of Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh to the north, Madhya Pradesh to the south, Karauli district to the west and Uttar Pradesh and Madhya Pradesh to the east. May and June are the hottest months when the normal temperature of the day rises more than 40 °C. On the contrary, December and January are the coldest months when the temperature is generally from 5 °C to 10 °C. The district is well connected by roads and railways.

### Muchchhkund



Muchchhkund, which is named after Raja Muchchhukand, the 24th of the Suryavanshi Dynasty (the Solar Clan) who is said to have reigned nineteen generations before Lord Ram, It is about 4 kms from the town of Dholpur. Having its mythological significance, it is a popular sacred place in the district.
