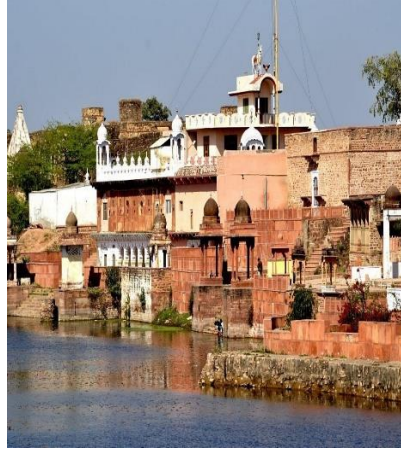

The poster should be brought for presentation at the Conference and submitted at the registration desk. The participants must prepare a 3-5 min verbal description of the poster.
